Safe Environment Training
We are ALL God's Children!

All adults who volunteer in our parish must receive Safe Environment training in a workshop called "Protecting God's Children" or "PGC". This training is:

- To help protect vulnerable adults & children
- Mandatory for all volunteers serving anywhere in the AOD
- Free through a website called VIRTUS at www.virtus.org

If you have already attended a PGC workshop,

please keep reading. You may need Recertification Training (good for 3 years)! It also means you already have a VIRTUS account with a User ID and a Password for your account (even if you don't remember what those are). If you don't remember, go to www.virtus.org, click on the blue "I Need Login Help" box (under the login box) & follow the instructions. If you remember your login info, please login to www.virtus.org and follow the prompts. Need other help? Please email helpdesk@virtus.org or you may email Maryann at mbrani@stanastasia.org.

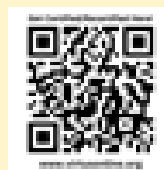
If you have never attended a PGC workshop in the past,

you will need to create an account and complete training. Safe Environment Training is so very important (and required) for most volunteers! We need your help and heart for others ... to take this mandatory training to help us keep all of our vulnerable adults and children in our community safe! Please go to www.virtus.org and create an account. Once you have created your account, save your login information and please follow the prompts. Need other help? Please email helpdesk@virtus.org or you may email Maryann at mbrani@stanastasia.org.

All Teens (ages 14 – 17) who volunteer at St. Anastasia must create a Virtus account in the same way as adults using the guide above. Teens will be assigned the "Healthy Relationships" workshop – which is a 35 minute, online workshop.

Children 13 & under: Are with adults/chaperones and do not need to take Safe Environment Training at this time.

Corewell Health / Beaumont Communion Minister

Every Sunday, after the 8:00 AM Mass, ministers bring Holy Communion to Catholics at Troy Corewell. You must be a "Corewell Health / Beaumont Volunteer" to serve at the hospital and strict safety protocols are in place. A 4-step training process is provided. You are able to schedule yourself every 4-5 weeks on a sign up genius. You are very much needed and are back home by lunchtime. Contact Kim Houseman at Ext 112 or khouseman@stanastasia.org.

Communion to the Homebound

Once a week parishioners who are unable to participate in the Liturgy are visited and brought Holy Communion by rotating volunteers from the parish. The minister visits on the day of their choice, arranged in advance with the parishioners. The rotating schedule requires one half day of time every 4 to 5 weeks visiting 4 - 5 parishioners. Funeral Lunch Team Leader

We are prayerfully considering offering funeral lunches as an option when a funeral Mass is held. In order to offer this compassionate ministry to our bereaved families, we need 3 sets of Team Leaders (teams of 2 people each). We are seeking Team Leaders (we are already blessed with setup help and servers). A Team Leader will be "on call" for a potential funeral for a month at a time. When a lunch is requested, the Team Leader contacts other volunteers and assists them with set up, serving and clean up. They shop for a few items needed for the luncheon (i.e. cream, lemonade) at Gordon Food Service (on account). On the day of the luncheon, a caterer will provide the food and the Team Leader oversees the serving of the meal. We need you!

Without enough Team Leaders, we will not be able to offer this ministry. We would need your help approximately 1-2 mornings a month.

Baptism Assistant

Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist (EME)

The role of Extraordinary Ministers is to assist the priest in distributing both the Body and Precious Blood at each Mass. The Body of Jesus is always offered. The Precious Blood is offered if we have enough EMEs present and are signed in 15 minutes before Mass begins. Training is provided. Lector

Lectors are ordinary people who perform an extraordinary ministry of proclaiming the Word of God at Mass through the weekly Scripture readings for all to hear. Being a Lector requires a desire to meditate on the Scripture and prepare in advance of each reading. Must be a registered, confirmed parishioner and have a mastery in public speaking. Arrival time is 15 minutes prior to Mass. Training is required. A Lector schedule is provided for 6 months in advance. Sacristan (Daily Mass & Weekends)

The role of the Sacristan is one of supporting the priest and liturgy itself and arrives 30 minutes prior to Mass. Daily Mass and Weekend Masses vary in responsibility. The Sacristan for daily Mass will lector. Weekend Masses there is a lector scheduled. Among other things, the Sacristan is responsible for treating all holy materials with reverence & respect, preparing all the vessels and all materials used for the Mass, cleaning all the vessels and putting everything away in the sacristy. Sacristan (Fridays)

The Friday Sacristan prepares and cleans the sanctuary & the sacristy for weekend Masses. The altar cloth is changed to the correct liturgical color. The Tabernacle is dusted. Holy water fonts are cleaned and fresh Holy Water is added into the fonts. Training is provided along with a rotating schedule. No prior experience is required. Wedding Liturgy Assistant
